



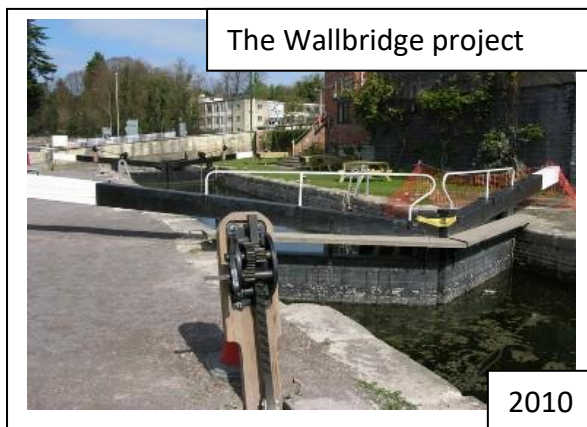

Q. Do you know of any recently completed projects in towns, villages or countryside that are really outstanding and contribute to the quality of the county's environment and the life of its communities ?

Nominations are now welcome from any source for the CPRE Awards, but nominations should have their owner's approval.

Projects should: demonstrate innovations and sustainable best practice; improve the quality of the built or natural environment; help enrich local communities – and importantly must be seen from public places.



Examples of some past awards include: community shops, village halls and other community buildings, nature reserves, community orchards, allotments and heritage projects. All buildings must fit particularly well into their settings.

An independent panel of judges will assess all nominations: it is not a competition and all projects meeting the quality criteria will receive an Award.
