The project is developing a definitive list of Stone Stiles in Gloucestershire. Most are unprotected and yet a valued feature of our countryside. Most are over 200 years old and we invite your help in producing a record of them, as a further step, to securing their preservation.

When the Project started in 2020 we asked Volunteers to submit any Stiles they found with a Form. This included permission for the project to use the images.

Over time we found that most volunteers sent in photographs by email, sometimes with very basic details. Most did not use forms.

2 By email

The minimum we need are your contact details (email), map reference for the stile, your photos and some notes to help describe the stile, for example is it on a public right of way?

Additional information about the stile can also be useful to help locate and document the stile. This may vary and include how to find the stile if hidden, anything you notice about the stile, maybe you are aware of changes you’ve seen to the stile, or footpath moving
